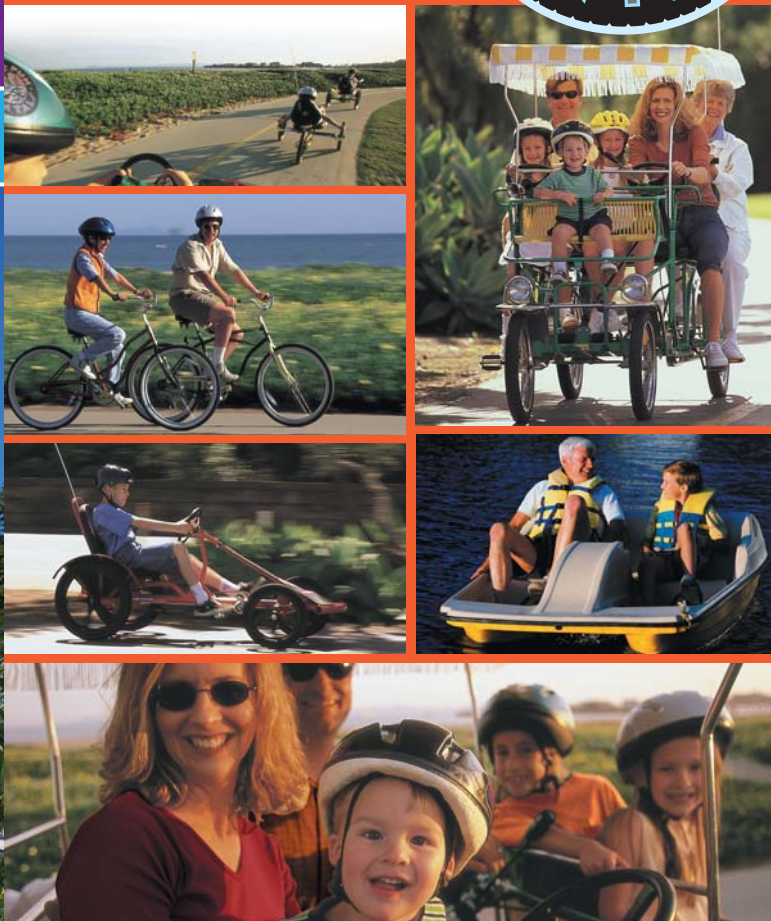

### SANTA BARBARA AREA

**Lotusland**  
Lotusland is a spectacular 37-acre botanical estate garden in Montecito, just east of Santa Barbara. Docent-led tours at 10 am and 1:30 pm, Wednesday through Saturday, between February 15th and November 15th. Advance reservations are required. (805) 969-9990 www.lotusland.org

**Santa Barbara Zoo**  
The Zoo is an adventure through lush tropical gardens in search of nature's most fascinating creatures. Over 500 animals roam naturalistic habitats. Picnic area, miniature train, carousel. Open 10-5 daily. 500 Ninos Dr. (across from East Beach), Santa Barbara. (805) 962-6310

**Santa Barbara Botanic Garden**  
Sixty acres of native trees, shrubs, wildflowers & cacti in natural settings. Easy walking trails. Historic dam built in 1806 by Indians. Open 7 days a week 9-6 March-October, 9-5 November-February. 1212 Mission Canyon Rd., Santa Barbara. (805) 682-4726

**Cachuma Lake**

**Old Mission Santa Barbara**  
Founded in 1786. The only mission church with two towers. Open daily. Upper end of Laguna St., Santa Barbara. (805) 682-4713

**Santa Barbara County Courthouse**  
Magnificent Spanish-Moorish palace built in 1929 surrounded by lawns and tropical gardens. Sweeping view from clock tower. Open daily. Free guided tour (call for hours). FREE admission. 1100 Anacapa St. (805) 962-6464

**Santa Barbara Museum of Art**  
Displaying sculpture, oriental art and an American collection of paintings. Open Tue.-Sun. 11-5. 1130 State St., Santa Barbara. (805) 963-4364

**Santa Barbara Museum of Natural History**  
Exhibits feature mammals, birds, fish, reptiles, plant life and the geology of the Pacific Coast. Open daily. 2559 Puerta del Sol Rd., Santa Barbara. (805) 682-4711

**Stow House**  
Furnished in the 1880's period by the Goleta Valley Historical Society. A working blacksmith shop and the Horace Sexton Memorial Museum located on the grounds. Open Sat. & Sun. 304 N. Los Cameros Rd., Goleta. (805) 964-4407

**Stearns Wharf**  
Oldest working pier on the West Coast. Sea Center and Nature Conservancy includes marine animal displays. Restaurants, shops, marine-related businesses and fishing pier. Open daily. **El Presidio State Historic Park**  
Original and reconstructed buildings of the last presidio (military) built by Spain. Open daily. 123 E. Canon Perdido St., Santa Barbara. (805) 966-9719

### South Coast Railroad Museum

At the historic Goleta Depot. Miniature-train rides, model railroad display and exhibits. Free Admission. Open Wed.-Sun., 1-4 pm. 300 N. Los Cameros Rd., Goleta. (805) 964-3540

### OXNARD AREA

**Channel Islands Harbor**  
Located in a picturesque waterside setting and known as the "Gateway to the Channel Islands", the Harbor is home to three nautically-themed retail centers and the Ventura County Maritime Museum, and offers eight full-service marinas housing 2,600 slips, yacht clubs, more than a dozen restaurants offering spectacular views, a waterside hotel and a variety of shops and services. Outdoor adventure activities include boating, sportfishing, kayaking, scuba diving and whale watching. The Harbor is the closest point of departure to the Channel Islands National Park. There are numerous special events and a Farmers/Fishermen's Market year-round. Fun for the whole family! Exit Victoria Ave. off Hwy. 101, 4-5 miles to Channel Islands Blvd. (805) 985-4852

**Ventura County Maritime Museum**  
Indulge yourself in a journey through time as you experience the age when great sailing ships ruled the seas. Observe maritime art and see antique sailing ship models made in the 18th and 19th centuries. Topical exhibits and featured guest artists change quarterly. **Heritage Square**
