





El Presidio State Historic Park Original and reconstructed buildings of the last presi-

South Coast Railroad Museum

OXNARD AREA Channel Islands Harbor

Located in a picturesque waterside setting and known as the "Gateway to the Channel Islands", the Harbor is home to three nautically-themed retail centers and the Ventura County Maritime Museum, and offers eight fullservice marinas housing 2,600 slips, yacht clubs, more than a dozen restaurants offering spectacular views, a waterside hotel and a variety of shops and services. Outdoor adventure activities include boating, sportfishing, kayaking, scuba diving and whale watching. The Harbor is the closest point of departure to the Channel Islands National Park. There are numerous special events and a Farmers'/Fishermen's Market year-round. Fun for the whole family! Exit Victoria Ave. off Hwy. 101, 4-5 miles to Channel Islands

Ventura County Maritime Museum






