There are five main entrances to Yellowstone National Park. Excellent highways lead to each entrance. This summer there are major road projects scheduled for Yellowstone. Current road information will be available at all entrance stations or may be obtained prior to arrival by calling the National Park Service at (307) 344-7381.


